1. Description of Violation:

Identify how the contract provision or policy was violated or misapplied.

Management failed to comply with PANJ PCR contract and maintain a Safe and Healthful place of employment by (1) failing to provide a place of employment free of bed bugs, (2) failing to inform affected employees that Bed Bugs were found in Lakewood, N.J.Judiciary Satellite Reporting Office, (3) failing to provide direction to affected employees and (4) docking the pay of the affected employees for leaving an unsafe/unhealthly work environment. After informing the Duty Supervisor that employees were going to utilize sick time, no denial was conveyed to the affected employees. The following day, the affected employees were informed that their pay was being docked. A subsequent request to file a worker's compensation claim due to their exposure of Bed Bugs was denied by management. Management unilaterally and unfairly reduced employees' negotiated compensation in violation of PANJ PCR and articles cited above by 1 hour and 20 minutes.

2. Description of Consequences:

Identify the specific consequence(s) of the contract provision or policy violation or misapplication.

Employees were exposed to Bed Bugs placing employee, employee's families, and public at risk for infestation. Management's lack of respect for employees resulted in employees being forced to use sick time that was denied at approximately 3:30pm, the following day. Management also forced employees to complete decontamination process and laundering affected articles on own time at own expense. Management's failure to comply with Sick Leave Article caused undue stress and financial hardship upon its employees.

3. Description of Efforts:

Identify what steps labor has taken to resolve the violation or misapplication prior to the filing of the grievance.

Attempts to resolve this matter with the Ocean Vicinage were, at this time, unsuccessful.

4. Description of Relief Sought:

- 1. Immediately restore all affected employees pay in full.
- 2. Deduct 1.25 hours sick from each affected employees allotted hours and compensate each employed with 1½ hours overtime for completing decontamination process and laundering affected articles.
- 3. Reimburse employees for laundering cost.
- 4. Reimburse employees for damage resulting to personal property and for expense of necessary decontamination process.
- 5. Reimburse employees for eradication of Bed Bugs from their home and vehicle, should there be contamination.
- 6. Comply with the current CBA (08-12)
- 7. Comply with contract and actively engage in relations with employees that treats them with Respect and Dignity.
- 8. Provide/Create PANJ with copy of Standard Operating Procedures that are to be followed during future similar incidents that are within the accepted industry standards for pest control.
