I am writing to join you in celebrating the life of William H. Thomas, an outstanding lifelong New Jerseyan whose compassion and generosity will live on in the memory of those whose lives he touched.

A veteran of World War II, William courageously served our Nation as a medical corpsman in the U.S. Navy Amphibious Forces and participated in the Invasion of Normandy on D-Day.
